

Delaware Bird-A-Thon Rules:

- → Time period: May 5 through May 13, 2018
- ◆ Count must be conducted during a single 24-hour period.
- ◆ Birds may be identified either by sight or song in Delaware, maritime boundaries included.
- ◆ Record birds on the checklist provided for count totals. → Wild birds only, no zoo birds or escapees are eligible!
- ◆ To be eligible for prizes, all checklists, pledge sheets. and funds must be received by June 17, 2018.
- ◆ Mail completed checklist, pledge form, registration or contributor's form, and collected donations to: DOS, PO Box 4247, Greenville, DE 19807.
