Delaware State List of Bird Species and the Delaware Review Species List

The Delaware State List of Bird Species contains the following 427 species of birds that have been accepted for Delaware by the Delaware Bird Records Committee (DBRC) as of February 2023. Two additional species complexes (Common Gull/Small-billed Gull and Pacific-Slope Flycatcher/Cordilleran Flycatcher) are also accepted at this time.

We request documentation for 96 species in **red boldface** and marked with an asterisk (*) that constitute the Delaware Review Species List. Species also marked with a dagger (†) are pelagic species that are only reviewable when seen from shore. The Addendum lists extralimital subspecies of common local species reported from Delaware that can be identified in the field. All of these marked for review and any other subspecies not on the list currently require documentation.
